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# What is the Apple login API?

The Apple Login API, known as Sign in with Apple, is an authentication service that allows users to log in to third-party apps and websites using their Apple ID.

This service enhances user privacy and security by offering the option to hide their actual email address and use a randomly generated one instead.

Sign in with Apple provides a seamless single sign-on (SSO) experience, allowing users to access multiple services with their Apple ID without needing to remember new credentials.

It also requires two-factor authentication for added security and integrates smoothly with Apple's ecosystem, making it a convenient choice for users of Apple devices.

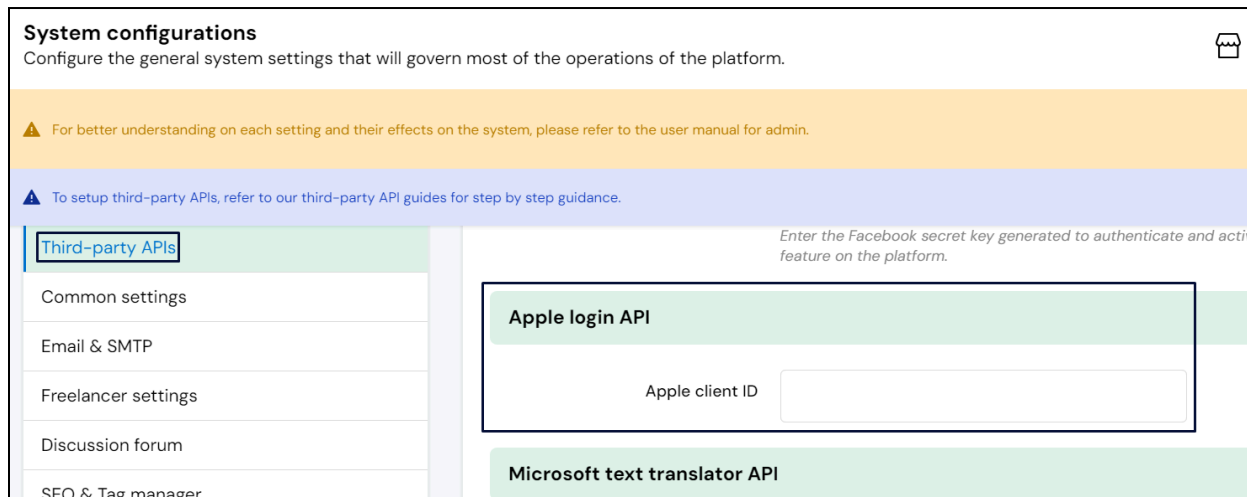
Yo!Gigs has integrated this functionality into the platform to enhance the user experience.

# Configure the Apple login API

Configure the Apple login API under Admin panel > Settings > System configurations > Third-party APIs tab.

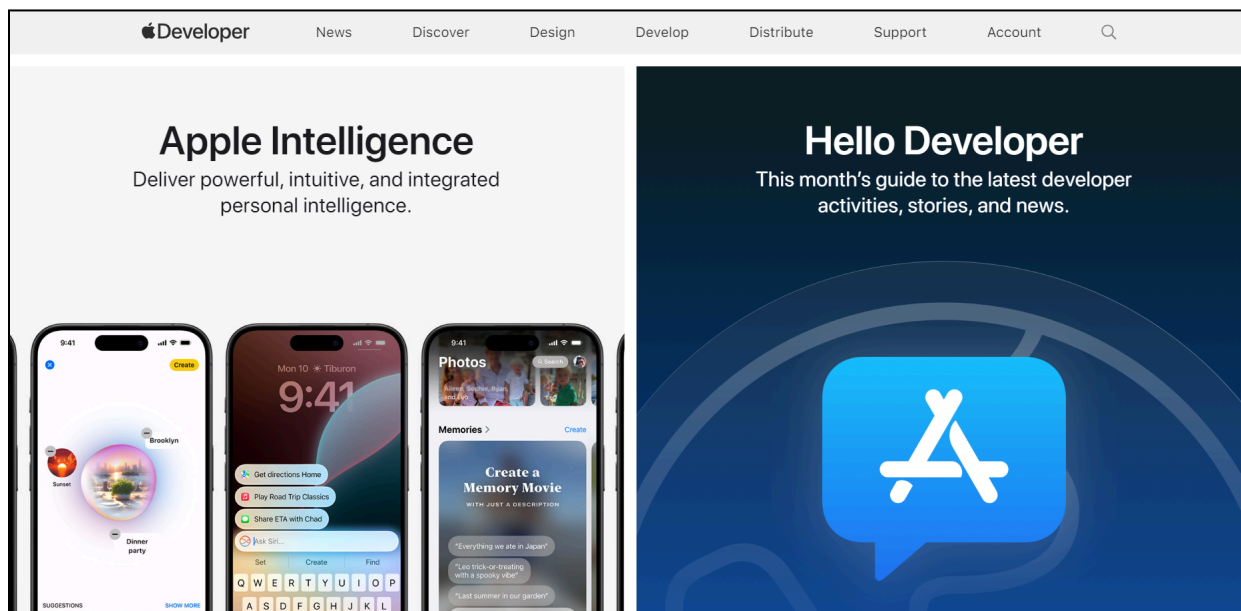


Here are the steps to obtain the Apple login API key:

## Step 1: Visit the Apple Developer platform

Visit <https://developer.apple.com>.

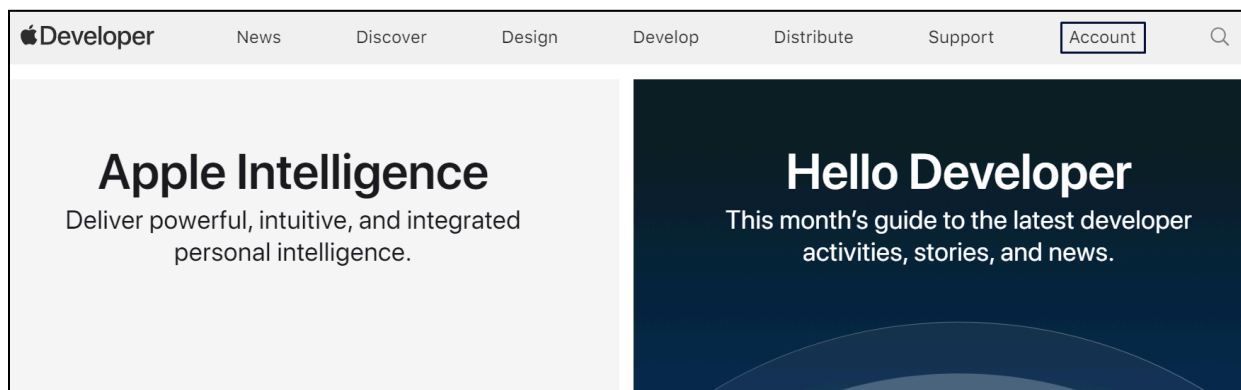

If you have an iCloud account, you do not need to create a new Apple Developer ID. Simply enter your iCloud email address in the field.

Similarly, if you already have an existing Apple Developer account (e.g., abc@gmail.com), enter that email address to log in.

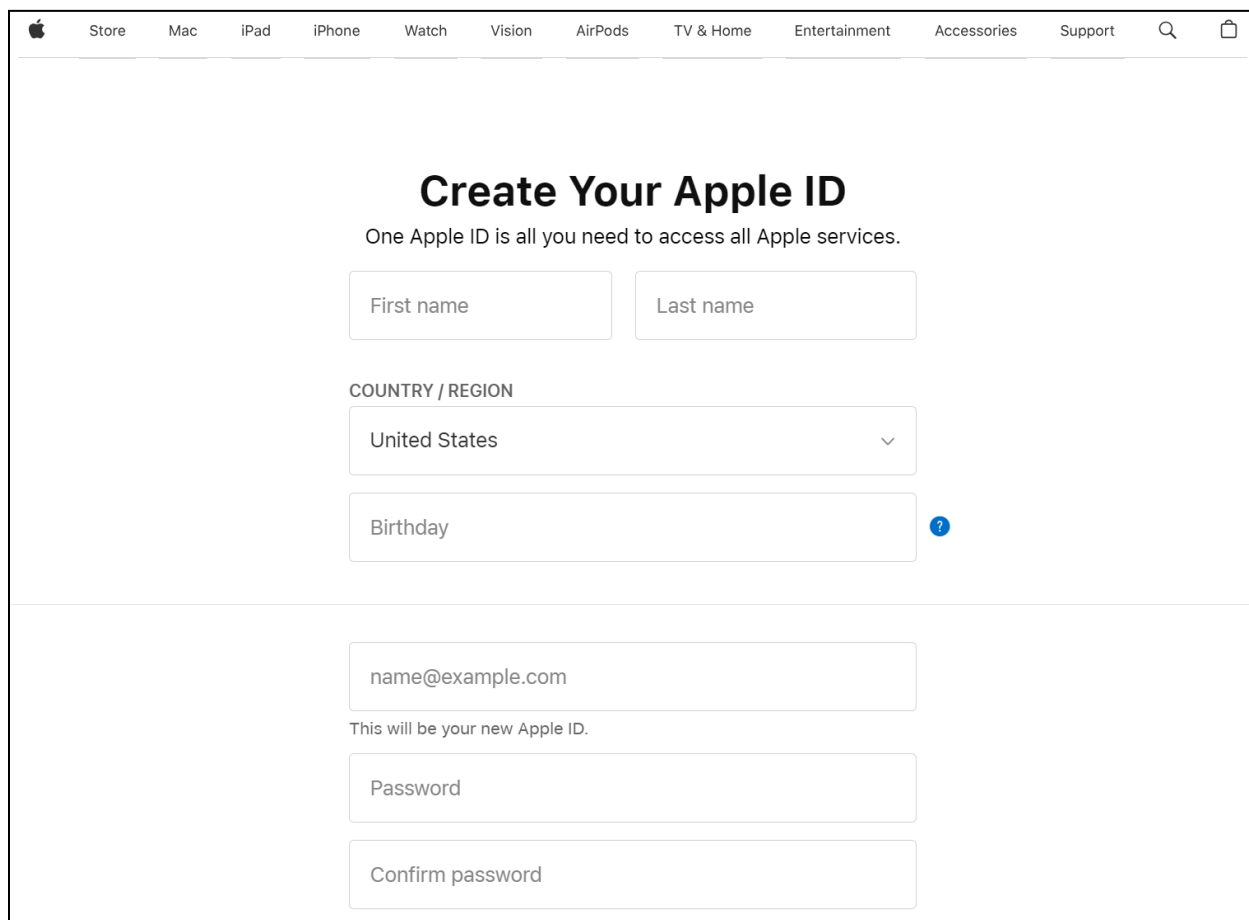
If you have an Apple ID but don't have an Apple device, only the **Continue with password** option will appear.

However, if you have an apple device, the **Sign in with Passkey** option will also be visible.

## New users

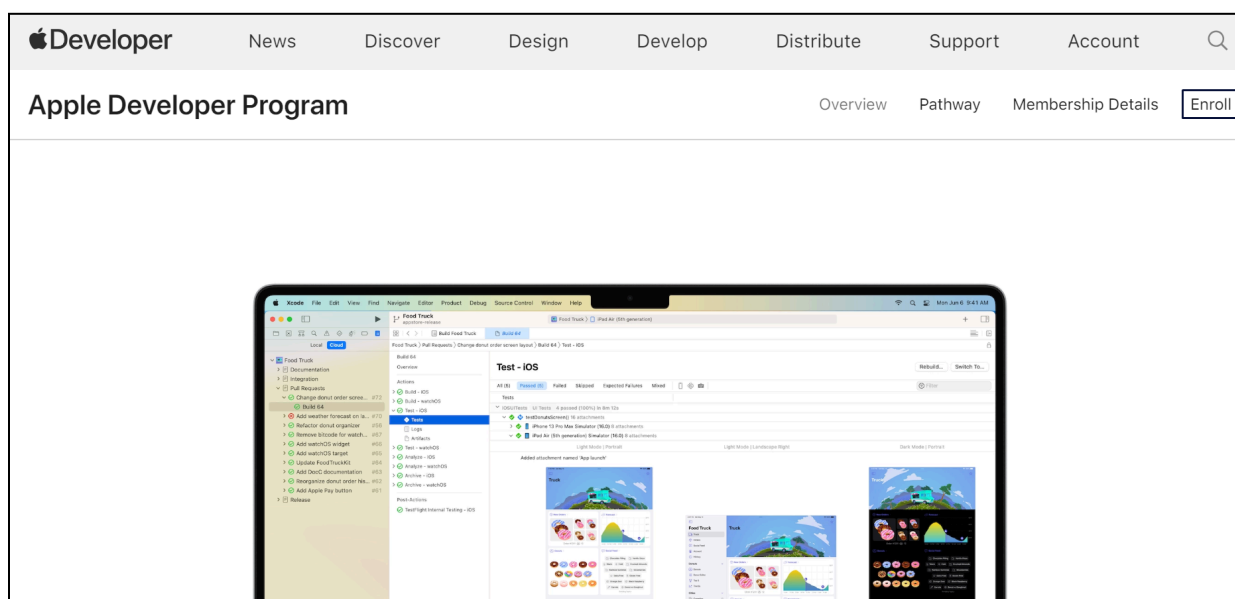
If you are not a part of the Apple Developer Program, you will first have to join it.

## Step 5: Create an identifier

Select **Identifiers** from the left navigation bar.



There are two kinds of Identifiers you are required to create - App ID and Services ID.

## Step 6: Create an App ID

Start by creating an **App ID**.

This is crucial for using the **Sign In with Apple API**, as it uniquely identifies your app and allows you to configure and manage your app's integration. This ensures secure and proper integration of Apple's login features while managing permissions and tracking usage effectively.

Follow the steps below to create your **App ID**:

### 1. Click the plus button.



Click  beside the **Identifiers** header to add a new identifier.

This will direct you to the **Register a new identifier** page.

### 2. Select 'App IDs.'

Under this page, select '**App IDs**' as it is one of the ways to collect configuration details about the web app.

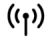

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## 4. Register the App ID.

Update the following details under this page:

- **Description:** Add the description for the app ID. You can add your application's name as the description here.

For example, yogigsv3.

- **Bundle ID:** Select 'Explicit' from the radio buttons if you are setting it up for your live app.

Select 'Wildcard' if you need the keys for testing purposes.

After making your selection, enter the unique Bundle ID provided by the mobile developer into the field located below the radio buttons, in the format – com.yourcompany.yourapp


For example, com.demo.yo-gigs.yogigsv3web





*A Bundle ID (short for Bundle Identifier) is a unique string that identifies a specific app or app group. It's used to distinguish your app from others and to ensure that your app's data and settings are kept separate from those of other apps.*

### Sign In with Apple: App ID Configuration

If you're enabling an App ID for the first time or for a new app, enable the App ID as a primary. You can use primary App IDs on their own or to enable identifiers for related apps and websites through grouping. To enable an App ID for a related app, (for example, an App ID for the iOS version of your Mac app), group it with the existing primary. This will also ensure that users only need to provide consent to share their information with you once for each group of apps and websites.

### Server-to-Server Notification Endpoint

Sign in with Apple server-to-server notifications allow you to receive important updates about your users and their accounts. Notifications are sent for each app group when users change mail forwarding preferences, delete their app account, or permanently delete their Apple ID. Each group of apps can have one URL, which must be absolute and include the scheme, host, and path. TLS 1.2 or higher is required to receive notifications. [Learn more.](#)

Next, create a **Services ID**.

This is also essential for implementing the **Sign In with Apple API** as it serves as an identifier for your app's authentication service. It enables you to configure sign-in capabilities, manage authorization requests, and link the service to your app.

Both the Service ID and App ID work together to ensure secure and effective implementation of Apple's authentication features.

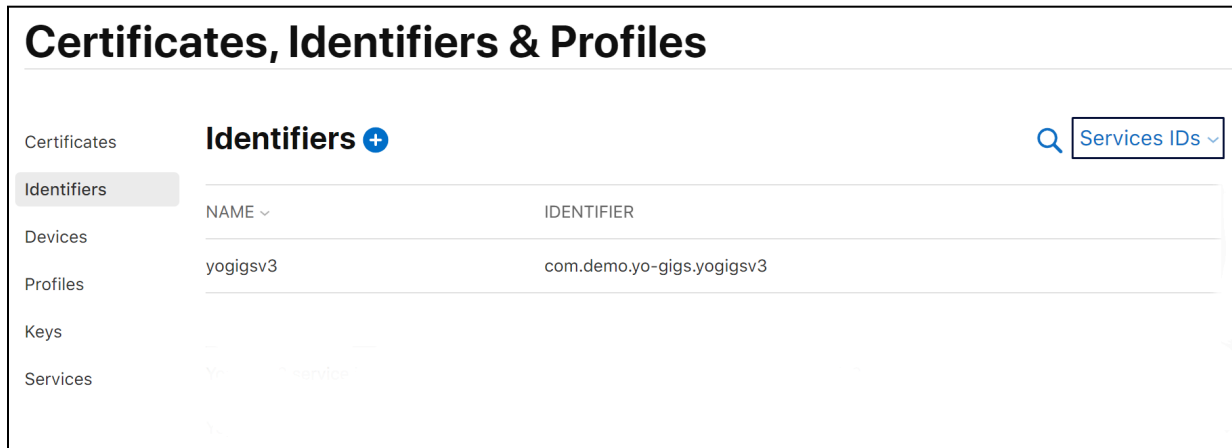

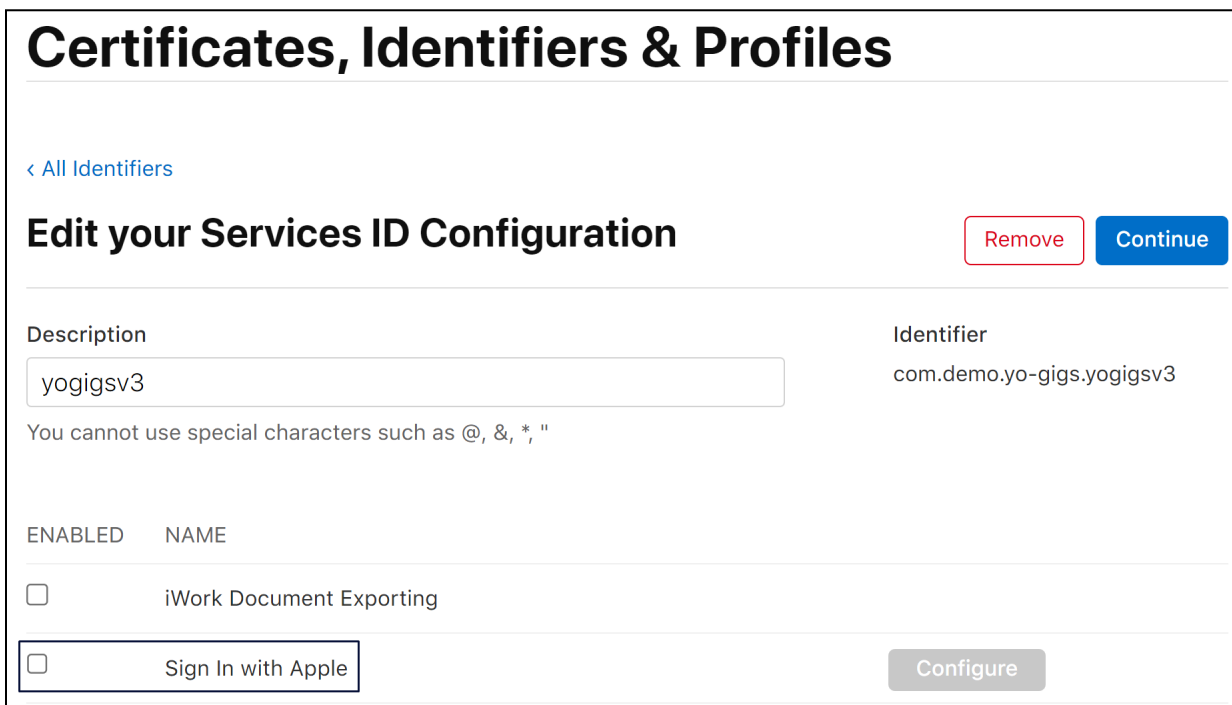

- **Redirect URLs:** Enter the URLs where users will be redirected after authentication as follows:

- When your platform doesn't have language specific URLs, enter the URL in the format:

`https://<domain>/guest-user/apple-login`

- When your platform has language specific URLs, enter the **primary language redirect URL** in the format:

`https://<domain>/guest-user/apple-login`

For each secondary language, use the URL format::

`https://<domain>/<langcode>/guest-user/apple-login`



*The language code is not required for the system default redirect URL, which is in the primary language. For example:*

`https://demo.yo-gigs.com/guest-user/apple-login`

*It is required only for secondary language redirect URLs. For instance, if Spanish is a secondary language, the URL format will be:*

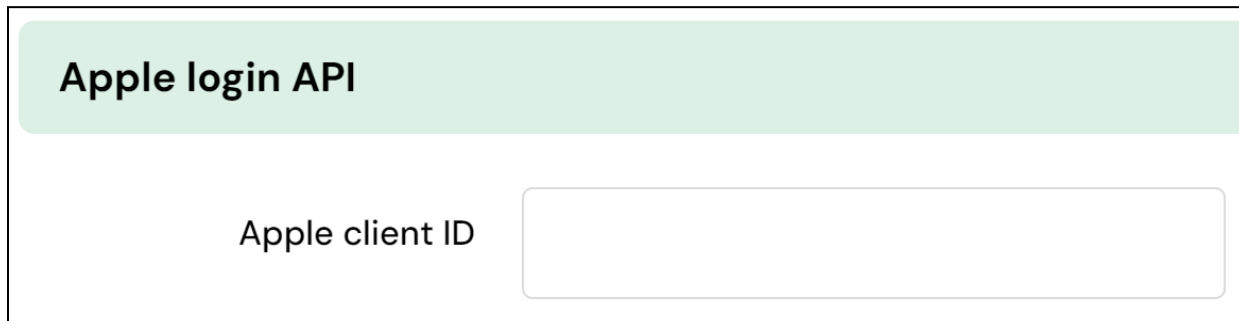

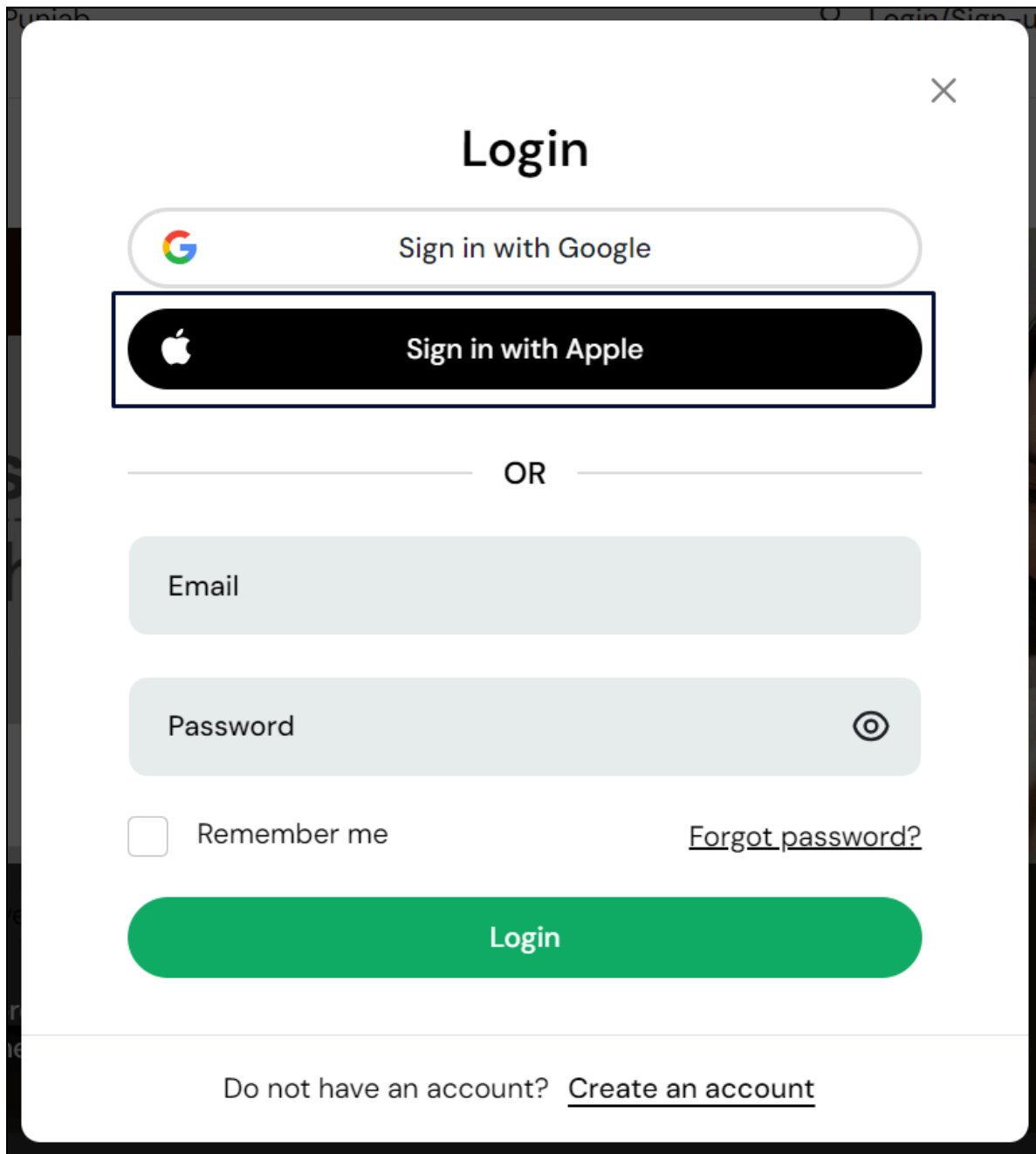
